
Do note that starting 2024, school fee in Al-Ansar Mosque Kindergarten will be \$270 monthly.

Staggered Arrival



Case Study

- Parent found out that child came home without her necklace.
- Parent asked child and child claimed necklace lost in washroom.

- 2 months later, jewellery was found inside maid's bag.







How often do you update my child's progress?
